ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

- Festival is Saturday, October 11, 2008 from 10:30 AM to 10:30 PM and will be on Handley Drive at East Lancaster.
- Admission to the festival is free and we have plenty of free parking.
- More than 130,000 people have attended the previous festivals and we expect an attendance of more than 25,000 at this year's festival.
- 2008 Festival will be expanded to accommodate more events, more vendor booth spaces, more artist's booths and more car show entries. In addition to the General Vendor Area, Artist's Area and Car Show, we are adding a Children's Area.
- An opportunity for you to display your talents and sell your art to thousands of people!
- Main Entertainment Stage will feature a variety of continuous live entertainment throughout the day with a Special Night Performance to be announced later.
- The Handley Community welcomes our friends and neighbors to participate in the festival and have fun, enjoy great festival food and fine family entertainment.

ABOUT THE ARTIST'S AREA

- There will be a designated Artist's Area coordinated by Lori Thomson of the Firehouse Gallery. Booth Spaces are \$45 each, 10' x 10' in size and electricity will be available.
- By registering early you will receive preferred booth placement and pre-festival updates.
- Mail or drop off your completed form at the Firehouse Gallery, 4147 Meadowbrook Dr., Fort Worth, TX 76103 by September 28, 2008. You can submit your **check made payable to The Historic Handley Development Corporation** at that time or be invoiced.
- Payments are due no later than October 1, 2008.
- Booth space set-up on festival day will be from 6:30 AM to 10:00 AM and no vehicles will be allowed in the festival area after 10:00 AM.
- Festival starts promptly at 10:30 AM and no vendor will be permitted to tear down until after 10:30 PM.
- Late Registration will be accepted at the discretion of Lori Thomson, if space is available, for an additional \$25.00

Historic Handley Street Fest Rules and Regulations

Festival is Saturday, October 11, 2008

10:30 AM to 10:30 PM

- All vendors must check-in prior to unloading. Vendor check-in and set-up time is from 6:30 AM to 10:00 AM and no vehicles will be allowed in the festival area after 10:00 AM. The festival will start promptly at 10:30 AM and no vendor will be permitted to tear down until after 10:30 PM. Vendors who have not checked in by 10:00 AM will be considered "no shows" and refunds will not be issued. Vendor check-in location will be announced at a later date.
- Professional food handlers must have proper health permits available.
- All food handlers must comply with applicable health and safety regulations.
- In case of severe or hazardous weather or any other act of God, there will be no reimbursement of vendor booth space fees. There is no rain date. The Historic Handley Development Corporation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation. Your fees are considered to be a donation to the corporation and are generally tax deductible.
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own tent, tables, chairs, fire extinguishers, 100' outdoor heavy-duty extension cord, lighting fixtures, food permits, etc.
- Festival officials shall designate selling areas and each vendor shall sell and display within the confines of his or her designated area only. Each vendor will be responsible for his or her own trash cleanup at the end of the day. There is to be absolutely no dumping of grease or other food waste products on the street or ground.
- The Historic Handley Development Corporation reserves the right to restrict the sale, display, or distribution of any printed materials, photographs, books, magazines, pictures, paraphernalia or other representations as the Festival Committee determines.
- The Historic Handley Development Corporation and its officials reserve the right to refuse admission to any vendor.
- The Historic Handley Development Corporation cannot be ultimately responsible for the Vendor's property. The Historic Handley Development Corporation is not responsible for any property left unattended. All Vendors are responsible for the proper insurance and protection of their property.
- It is agreed that Exhibitor will indemnify The Historic Handley Development Corporation and save them harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, actions, liability and expense in connection with loss of life, personal injury and/or damage to property arising from or out of the occupancy by Exhibitor of the premises or any part thereof of the Festival grounds, property, or occasioned wholly or in part by any act or omission of Exhibitor, its agents, contractors or employees.
- Any returned checks will incur a fee in the amount of \$30.00.
